N Street Village is the largest provider of housing and supportive services for women experiencing homelessness in Washington, D.C. Every year, we welcome nearly 2,000 women and empower them to make meaningful gains in their housing, income, employment, mental health, physical health, and addiction recovery in an atmosphere of dignity and respect.

207,871 nutritious meals served. (Triple the number from last year.)



365 days/year our Women's Day Center is open and providing meals, laundry, showers and support.



739 women and **51 families** were provided supportive housing in a loving community last year.


